#### Minutes:

##### 1. Polynesian Cultural Festival – review

*Andy Puefua said they wanted to thank everyone for helping with the Festival and were very happy how it turned out. The Polynesian community was very supportive and gave very good feedback. There was a minor problem with the speakers that were rented as the band had their own equipment and Andy said it was just miscommunication. The weather was nice and the committee said they had people say that this Festival was a big improvement over the one that was held two years ago. Camille said she had talked to a fellow employee from work who was from Tonga and she gave a great report about the entertainment and the food. Andy said that they received feedback from every vendor and they all were very happy in participating in the festival. Jon said the park grounds looked good on Sunday after the festival. It was mentioned that they would need more garbage cans for the next festival.*

*Steve asked about the Vendors and the fees that were charged and where the fees go. Matt Jensen said it goes to Duefua's to offset their cost. Matt said two years ago the city spent about Four Thousand dollars and that Pele spent around Three Thousand dollars.*

## 2. NSL Reads

*Lori Seppi said they have received many writing submissions this year. Conrad Jacobson and his daughter will be judges again this year. Lori said she will put together the certificates for the winners. Matt and Conrad said they would ask the Mayor if he would come to the NSL Reads event. Jon Rueckert said he would help Lori set up her video on the Bristlebots. Lori asked everyone to look out for a photographer that would be willing to come and take pictures. Conrad Jacobson asked if the Youth City Council could help and Lori said she would love to have anyone that could come help with the kids room and especially the Bristlebots. Steve Aase also mentioned that the YCC could go and talk to their English teachers about the event and see if they would promote the event as the author's book are geared around teenagers. Lori said that she has had quite a few writing submissions from teenagers this year. Becky Edwards said her sister is an English teacher at Millcreek Junior High and she would be happy to send her the information also.*

*Lori had a map of how she would like to set up the room and she discussed the particulars with Jon. Lori also said she would like a table with a clipboard for people to sign up for the newsletter. Lori asked if she could have a book club e-mail list. Matt Jensen, Conrad Jacobson and Jon Rueckert all said it was alright to have a book club e-mail list. Lori said she wants to send the e-mail list all the basic information about the NSL Reads and would like to use the official logo. Lori said she would bring a schedule to the next meeting. The event itself should be done by eight o'clock and with the clean-up after, hoping to be all done by eight thirty.*

*Conrad said there is a gentleman in Bountiful who publishes a mystery magazine on a regular basis in the newspaper and goes out to a wide variety of places. Conrad didn't know him but said he can be contacted. He will bring some information next week.*

*Camille asked Lori if she felt like she needed help with this event and Lori said that in the future she would like to see a committee who would help her plan different activities. Conrad reminded everyone about his little free library where they are welcome to take a book and return a book.*

Steve Aase suggested the High School groups. Conrad said he could volunteer a male quartet choir. Becky also asked if anyone who knew an organist. Conrad suggested Ryan Murphy or Russ Muir.*

*Becky said that the people she had for October has cancelled and will need to find someone else. Matt Jensen suggested the Army Band Wind Quintet group for October as a replacement. Becky said she would look into that. In January Becky would like to have the North Salt Lake Bells which is a bell ringer group. 
#### 7. 2016 Planning Meeting
