#### Minutes:

1. North Salt Lake Entrances
  - a. West Bound Center Street
  - b. South Bound Main Street

*Sandra Keeler said that walking down Main Street at the Overpass is scary because it is messy and is dark and while it is not North Salt Lake property, Sandra feels that there is something the city and residents can do to keep it clean. Jon Rueckert said UDOT has been shutting off the power lately and will see what he can find out. Sandra said that people come into North Salt Lake from this direction and they would not get a good first impression. There is also a walking path by the railroad tracks that the city put in but is over run with weeds which is another entrance to the city.*

*Camille Thorpe asked if this was the forum to address this problem. Conrad Jacobson said that City Council Meeting would probably be better served under "Citizen Comments". Jon Rueckert said he knew the place they were talking about up Center Street which is private property and the city does not own that. Jon said Union Pacific has put the sidewalk in and will talk to the ordinance officer. It was mentioned that Union Pacific owns fifteen feet on both sides of the railroad tracks. Jon said that*

*UDOT'S standard for landscaping is chain link fence and native seed and if there is anything extra then the city would be responsible. Tayler Clough asked if this wasn't a safety issue with the lighting. Nola Lucke said that the more individual citizen reports to UDOT on this issue the better luck of having them respond back. Jon said that he would like to verify that the lights are still out and he will give them a call. Conrad said he took the Youth City Council out and cleaned Center Street.*

*Nola Lucke said that the sign at the Eagleridge Roundabout is not working. Jon said that the power comes from Highway 89 and it was hit by a contractor working on the water line. Jon is working with the Power Company to fix the problem.*

## 2. NSL Reads – October 1st

*Lori Seppi brought the schedule and passed them out. Lori said she still needs a photographer. Conrad said he would help volunteer his services. Lori asked for any volunteers to come on the day of the event at five o'clock to help set up as they have a short amount of time to set up before it starts. Lori would like those that are greeters to make sure the people coming in know about the raffle and the goodies that they can pick up. The program starts at six and the first thing on the program will be the writing competition and Lori would like to see the Mayor hand out the awards. The children will be excused to go the children's room and Camille and her helpers will go with them. The children will be coloring and making robots. Approximately between six fifteen and seven o'clock Dan Wells will be talking to the adults and the teens followed by a question and answer time. Lori said she will try and cut that off about seven twenty. Lori has a gift for Dan Wells, then the raffle and clean up. Tayler was asked if he would be a backup for the refreshment table. Lori asked everyone that signed up if they cannot be there and are unable to fulfill their duties to please let her know so she can get someone else.*

*Becky Edwards said that Matt Jensen had called her before the meeting started and told her that he had contacted Jenn Wardell from the Davis County Clipper and she is really interested in running a story on Dan Wells. She asked that Dan Wells call her directly.*

*Conrad brought the "Guilty Pleasures" mystery magazine that they had talked about the week before for a possible theme for next year.*

*Lori said that they are going to do a training tomorrow night (Wednesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>) with all the volunteers for the children's room so they can learn how to assemble the Bristlebots.*

## 3. 3K Halloween Run – October 24th

*Natalie Gordon said the "Trot or Treat" event will be at Hatch Park at nine o'clock am on October 24<sup>th</sup>. Natalie said she needs someone to design a flyer and will talk to Matt and see if he would be willing to do that. Natalie said she will advertise it with Peach Jar, the Charter School, the Clipper and the Facebook page. Winegar's will need to be contacted to see if they would donate fifteen to twenty pumpkins and Zurchers to donate balloons. Lori will bring her music and Becky will let them use her speakers. Conrad said it is 5.7 laps around Hatch Park trail for a 3K run. Natalie said that every time they go around they can receive a little prize or treat. Natalie also said that she does not want to give out medals or awards for the winners but a prize that is geared toward Halloween. It was decided to plan for at least one hundred fifty. Steve Aase will bring water.*

#### 4. 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday Concert

*Becky Edwards said that the Concert on October 11th will be here at the City hall. She will ask Russ Muir to be the organist in November and is working on getting the Wind Quintet to come for October. In November The Second Sunday Concert will be held on November 8<sup>th</sup>. The Woods Cross Madrigals will perform in December. Steve mentioned that they can also advertise on Peach Jar.*

#### 5. Committee Update

*Camille said that we are heading into the planning season and will be talking about the committee at the meeting on November 10<sup>th</sup> about making sure we have people in place to make a difference for next year. Those who will be active members and participating in 2016.*

#### 6. Planning 2016
