## Do I need to Report That?

NSL Public Works maintains a myriad of things throughout the City. City crews are responsible for the maintenance of 63 miles of roads; nearly 50 acres of parks; 80+ miles of waterlines; 15 pumping facilities; and nearly 750 streetlights, just to name a few. As hard as our crews work to stay ahead of problems, sometimes things break before routine maintenance can prevent it. Streets get potholes; water lines leak; signs get knocked down and streetlights burn out. This is where we can use your

help. Problems can be reported via the city's website at [www.nslcity.org](http://www.nslcity.org) by clicking on the "Report a Concern" tab or by calling **801-335-8700**. Afterhours emergencies can be called in to the Public works after-hours number. Issues that are appropriate for after-hours attention include problems that may be life threatening or cause property damage (e.g. water leak or loss of water pressure, downed stop sign, plugged storm drain etc.). For emergencies such as these please call **801-560-3718**

or the police and fire dispatch non-emergency number at **801-298-6000**. Please call in those obnoxious streetlights that cycle on and off all night long; or the one that stays burning bright during the daylight hours. Let us know about the potholes, buckled curb and the downed signs. With your help we can maintain our assets better. Thank you!
