Great Tips from our Foxboro Neighborhood Watch

Know your Neighbors

Knowing your neighbors is the simplest protection for your property and family, from natural disasters to burglaries of holiday packages.



Ways to Get to Know your Neighbors:

- Be visible. Take walks and be friendly with everyone you walk past. Play with your kids in the front yard and invite other neighborhood kids to play with your kids.
- Don't be afraid to share contact information.
- Do something fun! Set up a lemonade stand. Have a front yard BBQ. Begin a cookie exchange complete with information about the family. Organize a progressive dinner. Host a game night or a football game viewing party.
- Get volunteering! Find a neighborhood cause and be a part of it.

Reasons to Get to Know ALL your Neighbors:

- More chances someone is home if you are locked out of your house.
- More people to see a delivered package on your doorstep and bring it in.
- More chances someone has that missing ingredient you need.
- More sense of unity in case of a minor (or major) natural disaster.
- More people to know something is odd when badness is going down.

Package Delivery Tips



Package thefts increase during the holidays. Here's how you can prepare:

General Suggestions:

- Track your packages closely. Try to be home the day of delivery.
- Have a place on your porch hidden from the street to leave packages.
- If you will be home, leave a note on the door asking the delivery person to knock or ring bell.
- If you will not be home, ask a neighbor to watch for you.
- If possible, pay extra for a signature.

FEDEX:

Have it diverted to the FedEx office on 500 south for free: Have it shipped to your house address. Once you have the tracking number go to Fedex.com and request that a package either be held at the terminal or held at a FedEx office location. There are also options for a fee.

UPS:

Check mailbox. Some UPS packages are delivered by USPS through the USPS mail system. You can call 1-800-PICK-UP to have your package put on will call or directed to another location such as your work, if possible.

How to Catch a Neighborhood Package Thief:

- Install video camera equipment- Check out our slides on home security.
- Pay attention to suspicious activity following drivers. If you see a delivery truck on your street making deliveries, PLEASE linger and watch for suspicious cars following the delivery truck. Be ready to take a picture/write down a license plate! **Call non-emergency dispatch at 801-298-6000.**
