### New Safe Exchange Zone at City Hall

The City of North Salt Lake and the North Salt Lake Police Department have designated a “Safe Exchange Zone” in the west parking lot of City Hall. This is a highly visible, well lighted area of City Hall and is under 24-hour video surveillance. It is also in the same parking lot that is used by the police officers as they go about their duties at the police station. As the popularity of online commerce continues to increase, people can utilize this area to meet and feel secure that they won’t become the victim of a violent or property-related crime. If a person is concerned they may be buying stolen property, they can request police check available databases to ensure the property being sold is not

reported as stolen. Another hoped for use of this Safe Exchange Zone is when people are involved in disputed civil exchanges, especially child custody or property exchanges. Calls for police presence, often referred to as a “Keep the Peace” call in these types of situations are common. The police officers often spend an hour or more just monitoring the situation. In an area such as the Safe Exchange Zone, disputing parties can meet in a visible, public, and recorded place to complete their exchange. Often this can take place without a police officer standing by. The police are still willing and able to respond to situations that either person feel threatened and would like an officer immediately present. The City of North Salt Lake Police



Department strongly encourages our residents to utilize this resource to its fullest extent to protect the peace and safety of the members of our community. If you have any questions, please call the police department at (801)335-8650 during business hours. The zone is available 24 hours a day and does not have to be reserved, nor does the department require any pre-meeting notification.
