Minutes:

1. Welcome Councilman Hood and Thank you Natalie Gordon

Steve Aase welcomed new Councilmember James Hood and introduced him to the NSL Live Committee. Steve said that they would like to coordinate the Easter Egg Hunt with James as they have helped in the past with the event. Steve went over the Easter Egg Hunt and Kite Festival in 2015 and what they did.

Camille said that Natalie Gordon expressed her enjoyment of being on the committee but now has other responsibilities and will no longer be able to participate on the board. Camille expressed her appreciation as well as the other's present on Natalie's important participation on the board. There have been names submitted to Mayor Arave for consideration so that a replacement can be picked soon. Camille submitted Lori Seppi's name and the Mayor had called her yesterday and Lori accepted. They will put Lori's name on the agenda for the appointment. Tayler Clough was interested in also submitting a name.

2. NSL Live Planning Meeting

Steve Aase said the first event coming up in 2016 will be the Easter Egg Hunt which is on March 27th. The NSL Live Committee will have to coordinate with the Youth City Council as the committee likes to help with that event and also to promote the Kite Festival on April 9th. Tayler Clough said he would like to see the same kind of Kite Festival as last year as that was a success. Steve said there were either two hundred or two hundred fifty kite kits and they went through all of them. It was the best turn out for that particular event. Steve said that one of the criticisms last year was that the crayons were too dull and that washable markers would probably be better for brighter colors. Steve said he would be in charge of the Kite Festival this year.

Matt Jensen said that he had talked to Becky Edwards about the Second Sunday Concerts. Matt said that Becky agreed that they could have the concerts start in June until the end of the year. Matt invited Shawna Gottfredson to the meeting who is interested in helping with the Second Sunday Concerts. Shawna said that would be great to start in June. *After Shawna left the meeting, she sent Matt a text message and was interested in putting together a concert in April and asked how much was budgeted for the concerts. Matt told her it was a modest budget and what did she have in mind. Steve Aase said that they have fourteen thousand in the budget for this year which was the same last year but typically they have not paid out to much of the budget on concerts as most of them are free. Shawna said that she would keep it under two hundred fifty dollars and the music would be classical sacred. It was decided to not go with the concert in April and start in June with the Davis County Symphony. The month of July will not have a concert but the other months from August to September will have a concert for a total of six for the 2016 year.

Steve Aase asked if there was anything the committee could do to help support Arbor Day. Jon Rueckert asked if there was a spot that the committee would like to concentrate on. The last two years were done at Deer Hollow Park. Matt Jensen said that last year there was talk about doing Arbor Day this year at Tunnel Springs Park. Matt said the committee could make a recommendation and the council can decide. After discussion it was decided they would make a recommendation to have Arbor Day this year at Tunnel Springs Park. Steve said that they could advertise this event with the usual places and use Peach Jar and other places that are free to get people involved.

Tayler Clough asked why Tunnel Springs Park was closed in the winter time. Jon Rueckert said they have problem with people driving out in the park and doing doughnuts (circles) and destroying the grass. Stan Porter said they will be installing cameras in the future and then they should be able to open the park in the winter. Steve suggested building rock barriers to prevent vehicles from entering onto the grass. Jon said he would look at the possibility for that happening.

Steve asked about having a grand opening for the "Get Into The River" grand opening. The yearly event is scheduled for May 28th. Stan Porter & Matt Jensen both said it would all depend on when they can get the grants and when construction can take place.

Matt Jensen said that he went to a meeting with the people that run the Utah Cycling Categorized Events. They have a full calendar including June 18th, which is the day that works best for Matt. He asked them to let him trade for the 18th of June instead of the eleventh which they have it posted as. Matt said that he sent an e-mail and told them that if they can accommodate his request for the eighteenth then he will go with them but if they can't then he will go on without Utah Cycling.

Matt said that the Mayor e-mailed him and asked if someone from the committee could represent the City of North Salt Lake at the Clearfield/Davis Cotopaxi Questival. Matt read from the e-mail and explained that the Questival is a twenty four scavenger hunt and is a county-wide event. Teams of two to six people are given a list of four hundred activities to accomplish in the 24 hours. Each activity is given a point value based on difficulty, and teams are trying to get the highest amount of points during the event. At each activity, they must take a picture and post it online. The post must include the hashtag for the event and activity, and their picture must show the token they are given at the opening festival.

At the end of the 24 hours, the top ten teams based on points are selected. The pictures they posted are available on the app and are judged by all of the other participants. The team with the best score after the judging is awarded the grand prize. While the top ten will win something cool, the grand prize winning team will be sent to Hawaii to participate in another Questival for the chance to win a trip around the world. Last year's winners leave next week for Belize for a Questival across seven countries.

It goes on to say that they have enlisted the support of Randy Cook to help with the event planning. We will tie the event in with the Warriors Over the Wasatch Air Show and the Tour of Utah as well. While the event will begin in Clearfield, it is their hope to show off each of our cities and the county as a whole.

Taylor Clough has volunteered to represent the city for this event. The meeting will be held at noon on January 26th.

Steve Aase said that the "Movies At The Park" is under the Youth City Council and it was mentioned last year that they would like to expand that event. It was talked about possibly doing one in the spring and in the fall. There was also discussion about holding the movie in the Council Chambers. Steve said that other cities do really great movies and North Salt Lake does outdated movies. James Hood said that the great movies cost a lot more money. He said that he just received an e-mail for the movie "Inside-Out" and the cost for that movie would be sixteen hundred dollars. Steve said that other cities have advertised their movies in Peach Jar and feels like the movies are not advertised well enough.

Steve mentioned that he would like to see a classic movie series in the black and white era. After discussion Camille suggested that anyone who would like to could send a list of old favorite movies to James Hood.

Lori Seppi said that they are going to do a subcommittee for the 5K Run and would like to do it quickly so they can get the advertising out.

3. Trails Subcommittee Discussion

Matt Jensen said that the trails are part of the Committees responsibilities. There has not been too much participation in the trails in the past as they are for the most part taken care of but Matt pointed out there is still some work to be done. Stan Porter asked that there be a subcommittee put together that would focus on trails. Dan Cottam was present and has been involved with the Active Transportation which are people who want to bicycle to work, or on trails and paths. Matt said that the trails subcommittee would be able to meet alone and Stan will be part of that committee. Stan said that there is only one big project that is left that they have been working on for years which is the Bonneville Shoreline Trail. The trail is mapped out but it has been sitting because there has not

been any funding. Stan said that after the vote in November it looks like the funding will be in place. The Davis County Trails Committee will be meeting on Thursday. Stan would like to see the North Salt Lake committee attend the meeting. Dan said that Bountiful City and the City of North Salt Lake are meeting to look at the trail alignment which has been currently been designed by a landscape architect firm. It is a chance to work on this section of the trail. The names of Juan Arce-Laretta and Michael Brammer were given as names with their phone numbers that might be possibly interested. Matt said that one of the NSL Live Committee members should possibly be on the trails subcommittee so they can report back to the NSL Live meetings. Lori Seppi mentioned that the reason she started coming to these meetings is because she was interested in trails and if no one else is interested she would help and would like to go to the meeting on Thursday at four o'clock. Dan said it should be at the Bountiful City Hall.

Dan said that there are three people and a big e-mail list who make up the Bountiful Shoreline Trail Committee. One of them lives behind Orchard Drive either in North Salt Lake or Bountiful whose name is Dave Roth. Dan said that what they are trying to do is go through the trail sections with the people of the cities associated with it. We have the southern end so it will be Bountiful City and North Salt Lake which is what the committee will be working on. After our section is completed then we will be going through the other sections in Davis County city by city so that everyone agrees how the trail alignment is. Dan also said that they passed the tax but they didn't know how much money they would have and how the money will be distributed associated with the tax. Jeff Oiler is working on officially applying for funding to build the trail.

4. NSL Representation to the Davis County Trails Committee

Discussion was made and included in Agenda Item #3.


5. Chair Notes
