**CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

- Street and Trail Preservations - Several streets and pathways in the City will receive asphalt preservation surface treatments this summer. Affected residents and trail users will be notified in advance so as to be minimally inconvenienced by closures and detours (usually lasting no more than 24 hours).
- Union Avenue Water Services - Beginning in June, culinary water services for businesses on Union Avenue will be switched from an old main line in the road to an existing newer one. Water delivery will likely be disrupted for short periods of time in coordination with affected business operators.
- Hatch Park Parking Lot - A permanent parking lot to serve visitors of Hatch Park will be constructed on the vacant lot at 103 N. Main Street later this summer. It is planned to provide 36 additional parking spaces.

• Questar Projects - We've been told that Questar will be working on Highway 89 from July until October. The NSL portion of Legacy Trail will be torn up in September through November for pipeline construction as well. Thank you for your patience through these projects.
