**CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

- Street and Trail Preservations - Several streets and pathways in the City will receive asphalt preservation treatments in early July. Affected residents will be notified in advance.
- Union Avenue Water Services - Culinary water services for businesses on Union Avenue will be switched to a newer water main. Water delivery may be disrupted for short periods of time.
- Hatch Park Parking Lot - A new parking lot will be constructed on the vacant lot at 103 N. Main Street to provide 34 additional parking spaces.
- Questar Projects - Questar will be working on Highway 89 through October. Also, the NSL portion of Legacy Trail will be torn up in Sept. through Nov. for pipeline construction. Thank you for your patience through these projects.

**FIRE RESTRICTIONS**



With all the moisture we have received, you may think we are out of fire danger. However, fire conditions along the foothills are actually more hazardous this year than in a drier year because of additional undergrowth. The City has passed an ordinance restricting the discharge of fireworks, open burning, and the use of any ignition source, east of Orchard Drive from the Bountiful City boundary to the SLC boundary and in all areas adjacent to the south curb of Eagleridge Drive.
