Minutes:

1. Polynesian Cultural Celebration (Update)

The Polynesian Cultural Festival will not be held this year as Andy is starting up a new restaurant and didn't feel like he could give the time needed to the Festival but would like to do it next year. Matt Jensen said that Pele called and wanted to do it but Matt felt like they needed to wait until next year when Andy was over it.

2. NSL Reads Recap – Lori Seppi

Lori Seppi said that Lisa Mangum and Dan Coleman were fantastic. They spoke to a group from seven to eight year olds to College Professors. She felt like everyone present learned something from their presentations. The audience was excited to share their stories. Lori felt like with all the advertising that was done for this event the audience was smaller than anticipated.

Lori brought flyers and posters for the Summer Reading program which were distributed among the committee to hand out.

3. Sunday Concert – June 12th

Camille Thorpe said the next Second Sunday Concert is on June 12th which will be the Davis Symphony and will be at Legacy Park. Matt said that there is not a concert in July and he doesn't know who will be doing August but in September it will be the Army Band on September 11th. The question was asked if Becky Edwards was still in charge of this event. Matt said he doesn't know at this time but doesn't think Becky is in charge and will have to talk to her. Matt said if the Second Sunday concerts want to continue they will need someone to coordinate the concerts. Right now they have four of the six events covered that they need.

4. Three Kings Race – June 18th

Matt brought the posters for the Three Kings event and the committee will help distribute them out. Lori asked if she could bring NSL Reads flyers to put in the goodie bags for this event. Matt said that would be fine. Matt said he took two hundred fifty flyers and dropped them off for the Porcupine Hill Climb which this year will be the State Hill Climb Championship and will be on June 4th. The t-shirts should be coming soon and people are starting to register. Matt said he will reach out to the refinery and make sure they have their quota of free riders. Matt asked if the Youth City Council would like to volunteer this year and James Hood said he would find out. Matt would like everyone to spread the word out and try to get as many volunteers as they can.

5. Festival of Speed – July 1st

Bruce Oblad was welcomed as the newest member of the NSL Live committee. Bruce who is over this event said he needs all the candlesticks that they had last year plus some cones. Jon Rueckert said they had one hundred candlesticks last year and Bruce said that was adequate. Bruce said he needs at least a dozen cones to mark the ramps. Bruce said he needs portable bathrooms and garbage cans. Jon said he would take care of that. James Hood asked if they could have two spots for the water booths and Bruce said that would be fine and could even have more if he needed to. James said that water and Mountain Dew worked the best for a drink. Bruce asked if the Youth Council could help pick up garbage after the event which would be very helpful. Camille asked James if someone from the Youth Council could help put the bottles in recycle bins. Bruce said the only food vendor that he knows that is coming at this time is "Cubbop".

Bruce said there are two areas where the money is going. One is to change the dates for all the signs. Bruce mentioned that he would like to get some yellow t-shirts that say "Staff" on them. Bruce is also asking for more volunteers and said he never has enough people to help park and needs at least a dozen but would like to get twenty. Matt suggested that posters be printed up with all the different types of cars so when people came with their cars they would be able to know where they should park which would also be able to help the volunteers. Bruce said he will work on getting it better organized. He also will call the Fire Department and get them lined up. It was mentioned that they might need the 18th green for overflow parking if they have more cars come this year.

Bruce said he has had contact with the two helicopter pilots and they both said they will come and also has talked to two parasailers who said they would be excited to come. Bruce mentioned that he talked to someone who fly's with a fan on his back and thinks he will also come.

6. NSL 5K Run – July 2nd

Camille Thorpe said that she and Steve Aase have been put in charge of sponsorship and volunteers and are working on that but are not able to attend the event. Nola Lucke will also not be able to attend the event but has been in touch with Dimitrio and he said he will do the timing again at the same price as last year. The registration is up and running on Active.com. Nola will post the information on the Utah Running and the Wasatch Running sites. Nola said that the application link on the NSL website is last year's registration form. Linda was trying to make some changes to the registration form but doesn't know where she is with that. Lori asked if James is going to do the racer bibs this year and Nola said he is.

James said he should be able to have three to five Youth City Council members come and help with the event this year. Lori asked if Jon would coordinate the Police, ambulance and the race course. Jon said the Police should have it on their schedule but he will check with them. Jon said he would also bring the water table if they need him to and will bring a garbage can. Lori said they would need to get volunteers for the water station and other areas as Alpine Cleaning will not be helping this year. They will ask Becky Edwards if they can use her sound system again. Lori said she will ask Steve Aase if he would like to contact sponsors to see if they would like to add anything to the goodie bags. James Hood said the YCC could stuff the goodie bags. James said that Alex Lucero, the pastor for the Abundant Life Church would like to help out. Camille said she will contact him. Lori asked about the flags and Jon said the city has purchased one hundred flags.

The race starts at seven o'clock and the registration will start at six o'clock am. Lori asked Camille if she would contact Mandy and ask if she would be over registration this year. The Bible Church said they would do the racer snacks again.

7. Chair Notes

Matt Jensen said that they have talked in Council meeting on getting shirts for the NSL Live committee for the events. Bruce Oblad said that he can contact Allen Simonsen who is doing the shirts for the Festival of Speed.

There was mention of the new city logo with the American flag that Rachel designed and everyone liked the new logo for the upcoming events.

Next meeting will be held on May 31st at 6:00 pm at City Hall.

Camille Thorpe adjourned the meeting at 7:05 pm.
