1. Recap of Assignments - Committee

2. Committee Tees – Bruce Oblad

After discussion the committee decided to go with a royal blue polo shirt with the NSL City logo and NSL Live underneath. The sizes were given to Allen Simonsen. The shirts should be done by July 1st.

3. NSL 5K Run – July 2nd – Camille, Steve, Nola, Lori

Camille Thorpe said she is responsible for volunteers who will help register for the morning of the 5K Run. Registration will start at six o'clock pm. Lori said she asked Linda Horrocks to put in the newsletter, website and social media that they need volunteers. Steve Aase said that he has not heard back from Jerry Seiner but will contact them. Alpine Cleaning will no longer be contacted.

Mountain America will do water and one hundred dollars. Wasatch Running should be participating and will hopefully be doing the prizes, bibs and bags. There is also a possibility of Smith's being a sponsor this year and Steve should know by the end of the week. Steve will contact Eaglewood for possible raffle prizes. Lori said she needs to know by June 15th of what sponsors are going to be involved so she can get the logo's on the t-shirts. Matt said that he could offer Dickeys coupons. Matt suggested that they give ten free coupons to anyone interested in running from the refinery.

Jon said that someone from the police department has been assigned to the 5K Run. Jon will get the barricades out and mark the course and he delivered the posters that he had last week. The flags will also be put out. James will be over getting volunteers from the Youth City Council. Nola said she has ordered youth small and unisex extra small all the way up to double extra large shirts. Timing and racer bibs are ready to go. Lori said she still needs volunteers with the water station. It was suggested the YCC would be able to do the water station. Jon said there is ice and water at the Public Works building.

4. Sunday concert – June 12th – Matt to talk with Becky

Matt talked to Becky about the concerts. She has got the Davis Community Orchestra for June 12th at Legacy Park. There will not be a concert in July. She has a group lined up for August which are Fiddlers. The Army Band is playing on September 11th at Eaglewood Golf Course. She is still working on October. November will be the Interfaith and December will be the Madrigals.

Matt said if the committee would still like to do the Second Sunday Concerts then someone else will need to take over. If no one wants to volunteer then December will be the last concert. Tayler Clough suggested Sandra Keeler. Steve Aase suggested the city purchases speakers for NSL Live events and not borrow citizen speakers any longer.

5. Three Kings Race – June 18th – Matt, James

Matt Jensen said he needs volunteers to be there at six thirty. Matt said the t-shirts are on their way, the timing people are lined up and he has talked to Jerry Seiner about prize money. Jon Rueckert asked what the city staff could help with and Matt said he would like the streets to be swept and someone there to handle the race money. Matt also suggested having Gatorade along with water for the racers.

6. Festival of Speed – July 1st – Bruce, James

Bruce Oblad said he needs flags to the entrance of the event. He would like to see volunteers come at five thirty. Bruce mentioned that he has turned down people who want to do music at this event because the next night at the firework celebration has plenty of music. He wants this event to be as low key as possible.

Steve asked how the budget was coming. Bruce said he has spent one hundred forty four dollars for the signs which he has picked up. The yellow t-shirts that are ordered should come in around two hundred twenty five dollars. There are some signs that need to be done on both sides.

7. NSL Reads Recap – Lori Seppi


