Minutes:

1. Welcome Visitors, Vendors and Volunteers

Camille Thorpe said she has three volunteers for the 5K Race on July 2nd who are Amy, Andrea & Sandy. Sandy came from Idaho who used to run a large parks and rec program.

2. 3 Kings

Matt Jensen said it looks like everything is in place for the Three Kings. Matt said he called Mike Taylor to drive around the photographer and called Winegars to donate fruit and they said they would. The registrations are down from last year. Matt said he forgot to call a DJ and called Becky Edwards and asked if she would provide the music and she said she would be happy to. The volunteers helping with registration will need to be at the event at six fifteen, the other volunteers can come between six thirty and six forty-five.

3. NSL 5K Run

Nola Lucke said that registrations are up and live on Active.com. She has talked to Dimitrio about the timing and he said that Chris will be over it this year. She was not sure if Dimitrio will be at the event or not. The only requirement that Chris mentioned about the racer bibs is that they would need the pull off tab. There are only ten registrations at this time but it was the same amount as last year so Nola is not worried because of the amount of people who signed up on the day of the race which was at least sixty five.

Taylor Clough asked Lori how many spots would be needed for the balloon skins and after discussion she will need four big bunches for the start and finish lines and three bunches for Taylor's people and all will need to be in the colors of red, white and blue. Lori said that Mountain America was going to donate one hundred water bottles, the Bible Church was going to provide Chocolate Milk and Gatorade and Smith's will donate five ounce water cups. Lori said she would take care of the music. Lori ordered eighty-five race shirts and thirty volunteer shirts. Lori would like the committee to think about making the shirt part of the registration next year. The finisher medals will be ordered tomorrow and after discussion Lori will order one hundred twenty five. Lori brought all the items to put in the goody bags that the Youth City Council will be over. Lori said she is going to do one hundred fifty gift bags this year because last year she took a t-shirt and gift bag to each of the sponsors and gave them out to the volunteers as well. If the gift bags run out this year, the volunteers will not be able to get one.

Lori asked Jon if he will bring four rectangle tables and Jon said he would. Lori also asked Matt to be the speaker if the Mayor does not come. The water should be set up and ready to go by six forty-five. Steve Aase said that Jerry Seiner wanted to hand out checks for the five hundred dollar donation they are giving. There was discussion about what increments to make the checks. It was decided to have One Hundred Twenty Five dollars for first place, Seventy Five dollars for second and Fifty dollars for third. Jerry Seiner will be doing the pace car with six volunteers.

Lori mentioned that they still do not have anyone to do the photography and said that if they cannot find anyone, she will ask a volunteer on the day of the race.

4. Festival of Speed

Bruce Oblad said he has his t-shirts ordered. Steve Aase said he would like to see the quality of the shirts for the committee before they order to make sure they are of good quality. Bruce said he knows there is at least one helicopter coming and might have one more but doesn't know for sure. Bruce said he has three food vendors and asked them to get in touch with Sally. There could possibly be more. Bruce said it would be good if the cones could be brought Friday morning at ten o'clock of the event. The different things that need to be organized were discussed between Bruce and Jon Rueckert. Camille Thorpe said there was an article in the Deseret News.

5. Second Sunday Concerts

Matt Jensen said the concert last Sunday was great. The month of July has never had a concert because it is a busy month. The group for August will be something with strings. The Army Band will perform on September 11th. Matt wasn't sure for October but for November it will be the Inter-faith

sing-along and December will be the Madrigals. Matt mentioned that if no one volunteers to take over the Second Sunday Concerts between now and December, the concerts will be retired.

6. Parks and Rec Activities in NSL
