- * Other repairs as determined by the City's Chief Building Official





DUMPSTERS AT HATCH PARK, FOXHOLLOW PARK AND EAGLEWOOD CLUBHOUSE

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- Hatch Park Parking Lot - Additional parking is being added on the vacant lot at 103 N. Main during September and October to add 44 additional parking spaces.
- Center Street Reconstruction - Center Street at 1455 West will be reconstructed in September and October. The Center Street bridge will be closed for seven days to complete the work. Message boards will be placed on Center Street to give drivers advance notice of closure dates.
- Foxboro Drive and Fox Hollow Drive Resurfacing will commence in late September. Some lane restrictions and road closures will be necessary. Work areas include: Foxboro Dr. between Cutler Dr. and Fox Hollow Dr., and Fox Hollow Dr. between Foxboro Dr. and Windsor Dr.
- City Street Markings - Painting crews are currently refreshing street markings throughout the City. The work will occur almost exclusively at night, so please be on the lookout for signs of men working after dark.
- Questar Projects - Questar will be working on Highway 89 through October. Also, the NSL portion of Legacy Trail will be torn up in Sept. through Nov. for pipeline construction.
