



**CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

**Hatch Park Parking Lot-** A permanent parking lot to serve visitors to Hatch Park is currently under construction at 103 N. Main Street. It is planned to provide 44 additional parking spaces to park visitors.

**Foxboro Drive Resurfacing-** Removal and replacement of failing asphalt pavement on this road is under way. Some lane restrictions and road closures will be necessary to complete the project between Fox Hollow Drive and Cutler Drive.

**City Street Markings-** Painting crews are currently refreshing street marking throughout the city. The work will occur almost exclusively at night, so please be on the lookout for signs of men working after dark.
