Minutes:

1. NSL Reads

Lori Seppi introduced her friend Mary Oscarson who came to tonight's meeting because she wanted to help with this event. Lori said she would start doing decorations around five o'clock pm but will probably be there earlier. At six o'clock the Youth City Council should be there and they will be in the children's room. At six-thirty is when the doors will open. Lori said she will greet Ann Cannon when she arrives. Matt Jensen, Mary & Camille Thorpe will be the greeters at the door. There will be name badges for everyone that states "Hello my name is _____ and my super power is _____." And they will also be getting a book mark and a raffle ticket. There will also be a photo booth and the photographer should arrive at six-thirty. Tayler Clough will be over refreshments. At seven o'clock pm is when the program starts. Lori will welcome everybody, thank the sponsors, outline the program and announce the contest winners. Lori would like the winners to take a minute or two when they receive their prize and announce who their super hero is. Ann Cannon will then speak.

In the kids room they will be making the capes and cards to give to their super heroes. Lori asked that the leaders in the room keep the children there as long as possible so they don't run in the council room where the adults will be until they are through with their program. Lori mentioned she will bring Lego's and coloring sheets to help. Lori mentioned to those who will be with the children that they could read the book first and bring out two different points. One would be to identify super hero powers in themselves and two is identifying super hero powers in others like people in their families and communities.

After Ann Cannon is finished, there will be a book signing, refreshments and the photographer will be available for pictures. There will be raffle prizes also given out.

2. NSL Trot or Treat

The NSL Trot or Treat will be on Saturday, October 22nd at 9:00 a.m. at Hatch Park. Camille asked help to distribute posters. Camille said that a design was done for t-shirts but it was too late and they wanted to keep the cost down so the event would be free. There was discussion about decorations and the sound system. They will borrow a sound system this event and try to budget for a sound system for future events. Camille said she contacted Chuck who will be the photographer. There was discussion about pumpkins and how many to get. Camille thought that fifteen to twenty would be enough.

3. Election Day

Camille encouraged everyone to vote on November 8th.

4. Appreciation Dinner

There are some conflicts with some of the committee members both present and former that will not be able to attend on November 9th and after discussion they will hold the Appreciation Dinner.

5. Free South Davis Rec Day

Camille said she contacted John Miller and he approved either November 10th or November 30th for North Salt Lake Free Day at the South Davis Rec Center. It was decided to have the free day on November 30th.

6. 2nd Sunday Concert (Part of the Fall Concert Festival)

Matt said the Second Sunday Concert in October featured Andrea Hughes who played the Violin and was amazing. She is local and plays with the Orchestra at Temple Square. There were forty to fifty people in attendance. Matt talked to Becky Edwards and they decided that the city would pay for Andrea and the accompanist for this concert.

There was discussion about an idea that was discussed in previous meetings about changing the concert series to just the fall and calling it the "Fall Concert Series" that would start in September and run each month through December. There was also discussion about advertising this event better because of how excellent the talent is. Steve Aase said they need to get with the poster designer right away to start advertising so he can put it on Peach

Jar and hopefully get a better attendance. Matt said they also need to go to the local band teachers as they require the kids to go to concerts.

The November Second Sunday Concert on November 13th will be the Inter-Faith Choir and on December 11th will be the Madrigals. Matt said they might be doing a combined concert with a Cello Choir. Matt told them to contact Becky Edwards and see if they could work something out.

Camille mentioned that the person who showed interest in taking over the concerts is no longer interested and will need someone to take the concert series over. Camille will go ahead and go forward with posters for the last two concerts for this year.

7. Planning Meeting

After discussion on dates in December it was decided that the planning meeting will be on Tuesday, December 13th. Camille will put information in the newsletter going out this month about anyone who would like to be involved with NSL Live and that they are invited to the December 13th planning meeting. Lori said that there also needs to be a survey at the end of the year in the newsletter and information about attending the next planning meeting.

Taylor Clough mentioned the Polynesian Festival and how successful it was last year. Tayler talked to Andy at his restaurant and said he felt like he was a little overwhelmed and wasn't sure if he would do the festival again in 2017. There was discussion about the value of the events that attract people outside of the city. Matt said he thinks there is value with people outside of the city attending our events but feels like the event is very successful if it is people from within our own city.
