


Center Street Reconstruction



We would like to make North Salt Lake residents aware of the construction that will be occurring this year along Center Street. There will be two separate projects along this corridor. The first project will be between I-15 and Highway 89. Currently, Questar Gas and Weber Basin Water Conservancy District are replacing their lines. When they are finished, North Salt Lake City will then install a new 14" culinary water line. Upon completion of these underground utilities,

Center Street will be widened to a pavement width of 43 feet and the asphalt will be replaced with concrete. The second project along Center Street will be from Orchard Drive to Marialana. Here the city will be installing a new 10" culinary water line. After this has been completed, the City will be reconstructing the asphalt street.

The City will do everything possible to keep traffic

open and flowing smoothly along Center Street this year, but delays will be inevitable and there will be times when the street will have to be closed to local traffic only. Please drive carefully during times of construction or better yet, avoid these areas when you can. We appreciate your patience in this matter. Dear Friends & Residents, As I enter the second half of my first term as mayor of our wonderful city, I continue to be amazed at the strength of our residents and their commitment to make North Salt Lake one of the finest communities in the state. Our belief in our high quality of life was validated by Money Magazine that voted our city one of the 100 best places to live in the country—23rd, to be exact. It is no accident that we find ourselves in such an enviable position. We are fortunate to have citizens, elected officials, and staff committed to making our town a better place.

I am pleased to say that the financial picture of our city continues to be very stable through some very challenging times. Through the last few years, the City's assessments from the South Davis Fire Agency have increased by nearly 50% and the City has

added police officers to improve community safety. During this time, the City's taxes and fees which finance our General Fund have shrunk by over 10%. The City has responded by reducing its employee count, increasing its efficiency and being selective in road projects to make up the difference and our General Fund continues to be very solvent without the need for any tax increases. Another exciting project that is nearing completion is the conversion of many of our large maintenance trucks to natural gas. This was funded in part by a grant from the state. With diesel prices on the rise, the payback will be much better than originally expected.

The City's utility funds, which have been distressed over the last few years, are currently recovering and are stable. We expect this to continue as the City works to arrange for additional

secondary water service to some parts of the city, including the golf course, which should improve its economics.

The City also continues to expand our park system which is funded by park fees from new houses as well as the RAP tax recently approved by our citizens in a referendum. The Foxboro Legacy Park was completed in the last year and a new east side park will begin construction this spring. We also hope to work on an expansion of Hatch Park including a separate gathering area outside our new city offices.

I appreciate the trust you have placed in me and I hope you are pleased with the progress we have made as a city. I would like to thank our City Council, staff and all of our citizens for their efforts in making North Salt Lake the great city that is North Salt Lake the great city that is.

Policy on Prayer at Council Meetings

It is the policy of the North Salt Lake City Council to begin its City Council meetings with prayer. The selection of those to give the prayer shall be on a non-discriminatory basis and shall be equally accessible to all. City personnel shall not

approve or examine the content of the intended prayer in any fashion. A thought, reading, poem, or the like may be offered in lieu of a prayer. Invitations to pray are hereby extended to religious and civic organizations as well as other interested

parties. Requests for an opportunity to pray should be directed to Marta Nielsen at (801)-335-8709. The prayer shall not exceed two (2) minutes in order that the City Council may proceed with conducting the business of the city.



House Numbers

North Salt Lake City has adopted the International Fire Code as part of our city ordinances (NSL City Code 10-151). Part of this code requires each new and existing building to have address numbers affixed to the building and

clearly visible from the street fronting the property. Recently, the code enforcement officer has been made aware of a number of homes and businesses that do not meet this requirement. Please help Police, Fire,

and EMS find your home or business quickly in the event of an emergency by ensuring address numbers are clearly visible from the street and affixed to the building they are supposed to identify.
