

Street Construction Update

We would like to thank you, our residents, for your patience with the Center Street construction. Questar Gas has finished their new line between I-15 and Highway 89 and Weber Basin is about 75% completed with their two new lines. They are currently working between Highway 89 and Orchard Drive and hope to be finished in two to three weeks. That being said, there is much more work to be done.

The City has recently gone out for bid on two waterline projects. The first project is a new 14 inch waterline along Center Street from 300 West to Highway 89. Hughes General Contractors was awarded this project and we expect construction to begin around mid-April. A second waterline project has just gone out for bid. This project goes along Center Street from 300 East to Orchard Drive and then proceeds south on Orchard to Eagleridge Drive and then through the Eaglewood Village subdivision. We hope to start construction on this project by mid April. The City is also in the process of designing a new concrete street from I-15 to Highway 89 and we hope to go out for bid in mid-May. One final project will be Center Street reconstruction from Orchard Drive to Marialana.

We apologize for the inconvenience this construction will cause you. The City will do everything possible to keep traffic open and flowing smoothly along these streets, but delays will be inevitable and there will be times when the street will have to be closed except to local traffic. Please drive carefully during times of construction or better yet, avoid these areas when you can. Again, we appreciate your patience in this matter.
