COVID-19 UPDATE

These are unprecedented times with conditions changing rapidly. We are all deeply concerned about the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and its physical, emotional and

financial impact on our community and families.

All of us are trying to adjust to some big changes like school from home, work from home, reduced

wages, long lines, short supplies and distancing at the grocery store, potential and real illness among us or family, and maybe even unemployment.

While this new paradigm has its challenges, the City strongly encourages all of us to follow the prescribed guidelines and take precautions so that you and others can slow, reduce and eliminate the spread of COVID-19. The State of Utah and the Davis Health Department have issued directives and orders that affect all of us in North Salt Lake. Following these guidelines

is especially important in our part of Davis County where we have vulnerable populations of older people who are at higher risk of serious or debilitating effects of illness.

From a City perspective, we are maintaining all essential services – public safety, water systems and streets. Building inspections, business licenses, and other services continue during this crisis by calling the City to make an appointment. (See directory on Page 2.) City Hall is closed to the public, and many staff members are working remotely from home to promote social distancing and maintain the ability to provide essential services. Public meetings are now held electronically and can be viewed or participated in from home.

Many spring City events have been cancelled, but other new events have been created in their place to involve residents. Watch the NSL social

We know that Spring Clean-up is an important event and we ask you to watch our social media posts and sign up for notifications through our website to stay informed about this event. We are working on options to replace our traditional clean-up at the Public Works building, and as soon as those options are finalized, we will get the word out.

As a City, we assure all residents and business owners that the City will continue to do everything we can to maintain necessary services while minimizing community and employee risk. 

We live in a relatively very safe community, and it may seem unlikely as individuals to be targeted in nationwide scams. However, the NSL Police Department receives many complaints each month about fraud and identity thefts. This has been especially true with the anxiety over the current health pandemic. Scammers are capitalizing on the fears associated with COVID-19.

NEVER divulge personal information, especially Social Security numbers, passwords, PIN numbers, or even a date of birth to a person calling or emailing you. Regardless of their threat or warning, get their name and call them back through a verified customer service number. Hang up immediately if they try to argue, threaten, or harass you.

Do not send your information via email. Most scams are based outside of the United States, but utilize phone technology apps and email/social media phishing scams to appear as legitimate representatives from a known business or local number. They often use logos, names, even email domain names that appear legitimate.

DO NOT BE A VICTIM

- ALWAYS VERIFY INFORMATION.
- KNOW WHO YOU'RE BUYING FROM.
- DON'T CLICK LINKS FROM SOURCES YOU DON'T KNOW.

PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER

The "Davis: Stay Safe, Stay Home," Public Health Order was issued April 1, updated April 14 and is effective through May 1.

DIRECTIVE
HOW INDIVIDUALS CAN LIMIT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

- Stay Safe, Stay Home.
- Avoid non-essential travel.
- Follow strict hygiene standards.
- Do not go out in public or to work when sick.
- Gatherings should be limited to members of a single household or living unit, except to provide care and support for others in the community.
- Avoid close physical contact by keeping a six-foot distance between yourself and others when in public.
- Wear a cloth face covering in public settings and whenever social distancing is not possible.
