Register to Vote: Voter registration forms are available at City Hall, online, and in the White Pages. Mail registration forms to the Davis County Clerk, PO Box 618, Farmington, UT 84025. You can also register online at www.vote.utah.gov. The deadline to register for this election season is October 22.

Vote By-Mail: Any registered voter may apply to become a permanent By-Mail voter and receive

a ballot for every election. Simply fill out an application and mark the Permanent By-Mail box. Vote By-Mail applications and additional information are available at www.DavisVotes.com, or call the Davis County Clerk/Auditor's office at 801-451-3588. Applications must be submitted to the Davis County Clerk/Auditor by October 9 for this election season.


Early Voting: Early voting starts October 23. View
