## A Fond Farewell to Brian Passey

After more than fifteen years of dedicated service to the City of North Salt Lake, Brian Passey is leaving his position as Finance Director and Assistant City Manager. Brian will be taking a new position as Finance Manager with Snyderville Basin Water Reclamation District. Brian has been a wonderful public servant and NSL employee. With his guidance as Finance Director and as Assistant City Manager, the City has seen many improvements over the last 15 years.

North Salt Lake has grown significantly: from 7,750 residents in 1997, to 17,400 today. Our municipal bond rating has gone up from Baa to AA status. We were able to pay cash for a brand new City Hall and Public Works facilities, after a 10-year plan of saving and deferred consumption. The City maintains over five million in liquid, strategic capital reserves, while in 1997 when Brian started his employment here, this reserve was less than one million. The

City has also been able to construct two beautiful parks in the northwest and southwest corners of the City through RAP tax funding, and from 1998-2009 we received over \$900,000 in CDBG funding for street improvements along Orchard and Odell Lanes. These are just a few of the accomplishments we have achieved with the help of Brian Passey. He has also been an outstanding employee and coworker, and will be greatly missed. sounds and spirit of the season with the Woods Cross High Madrigals. Traditional and contemporary Christmas music to warm the heart and bring peace to the soul.




## Volunteer Opportunity with VITA
