## Free Tax Help Available

If your income is \$50,000 or below, you may be eligible to have your taxes done for FREE and you may qualify for an Earned Income Tax Credit of up to \$5,800!

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA) of the IRS offers free tax help for low

income singles and families. Community volunteers are trained and tested in tax law and prepare individual tax returns at no cost. Free tax help is available in Davis County to those who cannot afford paid tax assistance, such as low to moderate income

households, seniors, the disabled and people with English as a second language. All tax help sites offer free electronic filing. Electronic filing provides the highest degree of speed, accuracy and security in filing tax returns.


