Construction Update

- **Deer Hollow Reservoir:** Reservoir, pump station, and transmission line to golf course are operational. Sod has been replanted over much of the park. The planning and beautification of the site will proceed through the next few months.
- **City Hall Park and Center St. Medians:** New Amphitheater and concrete walkways are complete. Irrigation system and larger plants have been installed around park area and along Center St. Installation of smaller plants, sod and final touches will be completed over the next two weeks.
- **Foxboro South Park:** Irrigation system and concrete flatwork complete. Playground equipment is almost complete. Picnic tables and pavilion are expected to arrive and be assembled this week. Planting of trees and sod to follow.
