

## Winter Reminder

The goal of our Public Works and Code Enforcement Departments is to eliminate damage to our fleet of snow removal vehicles. This translates directly to \$\$\$ saved for needed services. It is the responsibility of property

owners to trim the trees on the parkway of their homes so the snow removal trucks will be able to plow the roadway without the overhanging tree limbs damaging the side mirrors, windshields and doors.

According to City Code 7-1-4, Trees, bushes, or other growth, or the branches, fruit, or leaves thereof, which encroach directly up the street or sidewalk, or within **ELEVEN FEET (11')** above the street or **SEVEN FEET (7')** above the sidewalk, are prohibited.



## Construction Update

- **Deer Hollow Reservoir:** Beautification of the concrete reservoir is in progress and will continue weather permitting. New fence around reservoir to be installed by December 1<sup>st</sup>. The city will be hiring a landscape architect to design landscaping around reservoir, to be completed spring 2014.
- **Springhill Landslide Area:** Site stabilization commencing in November. Work includes installation of open channel to collect spring water to limit further erosion of the hillside, along with the placement of boulders and native plant seeds for long-term stabilization.
- **Foxboro South Park:** The majority of the project is complete. The picnic pavilion should be completed by Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>. In order to give the newly-laid sod time to take root and thrive, the park will not be open to the public or available for reservation until late spring 2014.
