

UTA wants input on the future of South Davis to SLC transit. Please join local transit representatives at a community open house to learn more about the Davis-SLC Community Connector transit study. Feedback is being sought on transit needs (both north-south and east-

west) as well as possible alignments, modes and destinations. The study area includes Bountiful, North Salt Lake, Salt Lake City and connections to the Woods Cross FrontRunner station. The study is designed to improve regional connectivity, match

Winter Reminders

Overnight street parking is prohibited between 11:00 pm and 6:00 am from November 1 through April 1. **Property owners are required to trim the trees** on the parkway of their homes so

the snow plows can clear the roadway without damaging the vehicles. Trees, or other growth, must be trimmed eleven feet (11') above the street or seven feet (7') above the sidewalk.

Avoid frozen pipes. Leave one faucet running slightly during extreme temperatures. This could save you and the city time and money.

Construction Update

- **Deer Hollow Reservoir:** Beautification of the project site is in progress. The temporary chain link fence will be removed as the wrought iron fence is completed. Additional landscaping and improvements scheduled for spring 2014.
- **Springhill Landslide Area:** Final phase of the project is stabilization work that will continue through the winter. Work includes installing an open channel to collect spring water to limit further erosion along with the placement of boulders and native plants.
- **Foxboro South Park:** The project is complete. We hope the North Salt Lake residents enjoy the grounds and picnic pavilion. In order to give the newly-laid sod time to take root and thrive, the park will not be available for reservation until late spring 2014.
