

## Volunteer for Homeless Registry Week Jan 29 – Feb 1

The county housing authority, hoping to gain a better understanding of how many local homeless there are and how services can be provided to them, will be holding a four-day **early morning** exercise of counting the homeless. The authority is looking for 50 volunteers to work in teams to interview homeless individuals for the Registry.

This is a four-day commitment due to the manner in which the outreach is conducted. To be part of an outreach team, you will need to attend a training session related to interviewing homeless people and completing the survey forms. Training is Wednesday, January 29 from 6 - 8 pm. The outreach event

## Winter Reminders

Overnight street parking is prohibited between 11 pm and 6 am from November 1 through April 1. Property owners are required to trim the trees on the parkway of their homes

so the snow plows can clear the roadway without damaging the vehicles. Trees, or other growth, must be trimmed eleven feet (11') above the street or seven feet (7') above the sidewalk.

Avoid frozen pipes. Leave one faucet running slightly during extreme temperatures. This could save you and the city time and money.



## Construction Update

- **Deer Hollow Reservoir:** Beautification of the project site is in progress. The wrought iron fence is completed, and additional landscaping and improvements are scheduled for spring 2014.
- **Springhill Landslide Area:** Final stabilization phase will continue through winter. Work includes installing an open channel to collect spring water, as well as the placement of boulders and native plants.
- **Foxboro South Park:** The project is complete. In order to give the newly-laid sod time to take root and thrive, the park will not be available for reservation until late spring 2014.
