### Minutes:

1. Fundraiser status.

*Camille Thorpe said there has been a lot of efforts and funds that have been raised to help the Utrilla family as she understands it. Hal LaBelle said he understood that there are still families that are hurting from the landslide. Conrad Jacobson said that there was an article in the paper about the Plowman family that is still not in their home but the City has said that it is safe to go back to their home. They still have concerns and fears in returning. Camille said it is up to the committee to pursue a fundraiser. Hal LaBelle said he thought the committee should keep the door open as the effects could be long range. Hal mentioned the younger Osmonds were happy to help and would just need a date. The Golf Tournament is September 26<sup>th</sup>. Camille said she would get in touch with Tayler Clough and see what direction he is thinking and discuss this further at the next meeting.*

2. NSL Reads – recap and thanks.

*Camille Thorpe thanked Lori for how well it turned out. Lori Seppi said she thought that the event was well received and she received good feedback. Conrad Jacobson said his daughter*

*was impressed with the event and was not used to having that many people show up to a Book Club Event. Lori said the movie went great without any problems. Some of the sponsors were in the audience and Conrad Jacobson said he talked to someone from Big West Oil and said he was very happy to provide support and be a sponsor for the City for events like this.*

*Camille asked if there could be a synopsis of the essays that the winners had written that could be shared. Lori Seppi said it would be good for next time to have a synopsis or at least a name of the essay or story. Lori would like to see the names of the winners on the city website. Conrad said he would like to see the public be allowed to read the essays on line. Lori said she could publish the essays on line now at Facebook and Twitter. Lori asked for pictures that anyone would have taken to be given to Lori or Camille so they can be sent to Linda Horrocks and put on all of North Salt Lake's social media. Lori also suggested announcing the winners before and listing the winning essays for the public to read and said that would be something to think about for next year.*

3. NSL Health Initiative – follow up

*Taylor Clough was absent and Camille Thorpe said that a date will be set up in the Spring.*

4. Hatch Park – Light and Stripes

*Jon Rueckert said that the electrician picked up the light from his office yesterday. He will determine the best way to put it on the flag pole. Jon said he contacted the contractor that will do the striping and they are backed up because of the weather and it being so wet. They only have until the second week of October to stripe but he said he would put us on the schedule. If they are not able to stripe it this year they will get us on the schedule for next Spring. Jon said they will put the basketball hoops up this fall.*

*Camille Thorpe said she investigated some Skateboard Parks and brought some pictures to show. Camille said she doesn't have pricing but has examples of how they have been able to fit a Skateboard Park into a similar kind of area. Camille mentioned that there is really nothing between Layton and Provo that is a Skateboard Park and was told that "If your City does not have a Skateboard Park then your City is the Skateboard Park". Camille said she would like to see it considered again. Conrad Jacobson said that Matt Jensen in the last meeting discussed that if we want to do a Skateboard Park we need to do one that the City can be proud of. Hal LaBelle said the committee had already decided on basketball and pickleball. Jon Rueckert suggested if the committee wants to pursue a Skateboard Park and do it right then they could get some information together and present it to the City Council to do in a year where they would have the budget for it but it would be put in a different space. Conrad Jacobson said that for the existing pad at Hatch Park there will not be a Skateboard Park. Conrad also mentioned that in the future there could be more space available at Hatch Park to put a Skateboard Park.*

*Nola Lucke asked about the bike signage. Jon said the streets department forgot to count the Cynthia Way Trailhead with their original sign order. The signs have been ordered and will be installed when they come.*

*Camille Thorpe said she will bring some pictures of established sign structures that could be put throughout the City at the next meeting.*

*\*Camille asked everyone to look out for any ideas for future events that apply to the Parks, Trails, Arts and Recreation.*
