#### Minutes:

1. Bonneville Shoreline Trail committee members to present to NSL Live

*Michael Brammer is a citizen of North Salt Lake and attended a meeting a couple of months ago on the Bonneville Shoreline Trail. Michael said he was shown a proposed trail map that was mapped out from here to Ogden and wanted to help but is not on the Bonneville Shoreline Trail committee. Michael said he was hoping to bring a couple of committee members to this meeting but they had not responded to his e-mails. Michael said he would like to know the steps on how to approach the City Council and their formalities.*

*Matt Jensen said he has seen the maps of the rerouting of the Bonneville Shoreline Trail and the City Council is supportive of it. The land that the City owns at Tunnel Springs Park is about one-third of it. Matt said the City would like to see the trail more useful and less urban and would like to get a map and have someone survey where the trail could go. Matt said that Stan Porter on the City Council*

*would know of an individual who could survey and map out the trail who has done it before. The Bonneville Shoreline Trail committee should come to the NSL Live committee first before going to the City Council meeting.*

2. NSL Reads – Announcement, poster and flyer

*Lori Seppi said the posters are ready to go and e-mailed it to Linda Horrocks and Steve Aase. Linda is out of town and may not get on the website until she comes back.*

3. Easter Egg Hunt, Kite demonstration and Martial Arts demonstration

*Conrad Jacobson said the Youth City Council will be Hatch Park at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday morning to set up and the NSL Live committee could come at 8:00 a.m. to help. Conrad said he told the Martial Arts that they could have a block time for their demonstration from 8:35 to 8:55 a.m. just north of concession stand. Steve Aase said the Kite demonstration will happen right after the Easter Egg Hunt and will be on the western grass. Conrad said on the southeast side of the grass area will be blocked off for special needs children.*

*Steve Aase wanted to announce the Kite Festival and asked how they could do that. Conrad said that the Martial Arts people are going to bring their own sound system with a microphone and could ask them if they could use it to announce the Kite Festival. Steve said he would contact them and see if it would be alright for them to use their system. Matt also suggested that the volunteers take flyers for the Kite Festival and stand in the middle at the different fields and announce the Kite Festival and handout as many flyers as they can.*

*Steve brought up the events that are coming up. Camille wanted to put the events on the back of the flyers that will be handed out at the Easter Egg Hunt. They wanted the Second Sunday concert, Arbor Day and Get Into The River event announced and posted on the flyers. Matt said he would check with Becky Edwards and e-mail Steve with the Second Sunday Concert information.*

4. Kite Festival – April 4<sup>th</sup> for demonstration and flyers (invitation to Kite Festival on April 18<sup>th</sup> at Legacy Park at 2 p.m.)

*Steve Aase said that they are getting a better quality Japanese Sled kite which are easier to fly. They are made of a material that the kids can color on and will be able to personalize their own kite. Also, they will have different color of tails to attach. Steve mentioned that there can be no more than 4 feet of tail on the kite and it needs to be balanced. Camille Thorpe asked Steve to write down the steps for the kite as Steve will not be present on April 18<sup>th</sup>. Steve said that ten kites will cost thirty dollars or three dollars apiece. After discussion it was decided that Steve would order 200 kites.*

5. Arbor Day – April 25<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m. at Deer Hollow Park

*There will be approximately twenty to thirty trees that will be planted.*

6. Next meeting at Dickey's on April 14<sup>th</sup>

*This will be a NSL Live committee meeting with invitation to family members to join.*

## 7. 3 Kings Bike Race

*Matt Jensen handed out a budget from last year. Matt mentioned that there was also three hundred dollars in prize money.*

*Tayler Clough said he would like to see the logo with the turbin on one of the three kings changed from previous years as it could be offensive to some people and would like to see a better image. Matt Jensen said that there could be a problem with changing the design as they have created banners, jerseys and stickers for the back of cars. Tayler said he still would like to see the logo changed. After discussion it was decided that Matt would ask the designer to come up with a different design and will phase out the current image. Tayler mentioned that Skyline High School does amazing banners and has a good graphics program and would be inexpensive.*

*Nola Lucke said that there are banners that are being covered with weeds. Sally Beyer said she would contact the parks department and have the weeds cut down.*

## 8. NSL Acts

*Steve Aase said that the play will be on August 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> and the website, newsletter and calendar will need to be changed. Tayler Clough asked if they need to meet with Natalie Gordon's friends. Steve said that they were not ready to do anything this year. Tayler also asked about the survey that was taken and if there were a list available of kids who participated last year. There was discussion about the survey and Steve said he would try and find out if there is a list of kids who participated last year.*

*Conrad Jacobson mentioned that he would like to see the plays have more North Salt Lake residents participate. After discussion Matt Jensen said the value for this event is sponsoring something that is a venue for families in our community to participate. Steve Aase said last year there was a co-sponsorship with Orchard Elementary and their students were able to get a discount. The children outside of our community will have to pay a higher fee. Steve said we could approach a different school for this year. Steve Aase suggested that they could have eight one-half need based scholarships that could be given for North Salt Lake residents. Matt Jensen said we would need to be careful how we promote the scholarships and what to put on the applications. Tayler said he knows of some contacts at the University of Utah that he could work with on the application.*

*The proposed play will be Peter Pan which Steve and Camille said was a great play.*

## 9. 5K Run (June 27<sup>th</sup> details)

*Nola Lucke said they are working on the registration form and as they were looking at the city's website, there were problems found because it was showing the year 2013 and didn't have a current date. Nola said it has been fixed because you cannot go to that site anymore and states "2015 – more details to come".*

*Lori Seppi said they have divided the assignments. Nola is doing the registration, Natalie Gordon is doing the t-shirts and medals, and Lori will do the day of activities with the help of volunteers. Matt said there are usually plenty of volunteers on the day of the race. Lori said she is trying to attract families where everyone feels welcome and the new logo will have a flag on it. The route will be the same as last year and there will be participation medals handed out.*

*\*Steve Aase went over the different events that could be advertised on Peach Tree. They will advertise anything for free that is free to the public. They also requested what they advertise to be colorful. It was suggested to put more than one event on a flyer when there are months that have multiple events.*
