Minutes:

1. 3 Kings Bike Race

Camille excused Matt Jensen & Conrad Jacobson from tonight's meetings as they had City Council Meeting.

**Andy Duefua was present and gave his outline of where he would like to see the Polynesian Festival go this year. Andy said he is helping his father plan this year for a better festival and was hoping they could hold it in August on a Friday evening to kick the festival off and then it will run through Saturday. Andy mentioned that the festival two years ago brought around two hundred people and would like to see those numbers increase significantly. Andy said he would like to discuss the*

funding of the lights, tents and portable restrooms that the City had paid for with the last festival. Steve Aase suggested that a proposal of how much it would cost for the different items they would need and bring it to Council Meeting. Steve mentioned that the city spent around thirty-five hundred dollars for the last festival.

Andy said he would like to try and have a mini Polynesian Cultural Center experience with demonstrations of the different foods and activities that the different Polynesian cultures have. Andy mentioned he would like to advertise a lot more this year with social media, posters & banners. After discussion it was decided that Andy would need to contact the city and see what dates are available in August and bring them back to the next meeting on June 9th. Steve Aase also mentioned that they could get it advertised through the school system for no charge if there is not a charge for the event.

***Matt Jensen brought in different logos to view for the 3 Kings Bike Race and would like feedback. After the committee had viewed the different logos they were all in agreement about the logo they liked the best. Steve Aase quickly went over with Matt what Andy Duefua had presented to the committee about the Polynesian Festival.*

****Lori Seppi asked if she could borrow the sound system from Becky Edwards for the 5K Run on June 27th and Becky said she could.*

*****Becky Edwards said she needs to confirm with Matt Jensen about the Second Sunday Concert on September 13th with the Army Band and also needs to check on August 9th with the Bean family.*

2. Movies At The Park

Steve Aase said that the "Movies At The Park" will be on Friday nights and is starting on July 31st and running through August 7th and 14th. The movies that will be showing this year are "Enchanted", "Pete's Dragon" and "Despicable Me".

3. 2015 Calendar

Camille Thorpe asked if there were any conflicts with the calendaring. Steve Aase said there was a conflict with the play on August 14th and 15th that wouldn't work so they moved it to August 21st and 22nd.

4. NSL Healthy

Taylor Clough said he would like to do a more service type activity for the third week on August 17th. Taylor said two years ago he and his friend did a free preventative health clinic in downtown Salt Lake for a couple of hours. His mother-in-law came and tested for diabetes, a dental school and ophthalmologist came and did a brief checkup. Steve Aase mentioned that LDS Hospital wanted to partner with North Salt Lake and could be a great help for this kind of activity. Taylor also said that he has a friend that owns a cross fitness gym who does moderate exercise. Taylor asked him if he or one of his trainers would be interested in coming and doing a simple exercise demonstration and also talk about how to keep fit on August 3rd and he showed an interest in doing that.

Taylor said he would like suggestions on kicking the NSL Healthy off with the first week being around service. Taylor said he was thinking about working with Neighborhood House and see if they could

provide an activity to do. Tayler also mentioned the professor who could come and talk about the Bonneville Shoreline Trail and he also knows a chef who used to work at Market Street Grill and thought about asking him to talk about food preparation. Steve Aase brought up a dentist who works in a clinic on Redwood Road in North Salt Lake who specializes in youth dentistry.

Tayler said he envisions "Healthy Cooking, Healthy Exercise & Healthy Bodies". He would like to see a punch card type of system that people could earn stamps as they participate in the activity. There was discussion about prizes to be given out and it was decided to have multiple small baskets with a large basket as the grand prize. Steve Aase brought up the restaurant "Thymes and Seasons" who is owned by Hai Fitzgerald that is located in North Salt Lake as a possibility for the week of healthy foods. Tayler said he would call Hai and see if he would be willing to participate for the cooking demonstration and will call LDS Hospital.

There was some discussion on the best way would be to advertise and market this event. Steve Aase said because it is a free event it could go out to the school on Peach Jar which would go to everyone with children. Steve said that there needs to be a disclosure on the bottom of the poster and will e-mail the disclosure to Tayler.

Tayler said he would like to start at 6:30 pm and have Legacy Park be on August 3rd, Hatch Park on August 10th and end up with Tunnel Springs Park on August 17th. Camille Thorpe said she would call and make arrangements with the city for the parks. Tayler asked if NSL Live will pay for people like his Marshall Arts friend to come and do his demonstration. Steve Aase said if people come to promote their own business, then NSL Live will not pay.

There was discussion on what to call this event and Camille came up with "NSL Live and Well" which Tayler liked. Tayler would like to meet on May 26th with a sub-committee to finalize the event.

5. NSL Acts (Theater)

Steve Aase said that Laura Brown is concerned with the dates of August 21st and 22nd because it is a weekend before school starts and if that would bring attendance down. After discussion it was decided to leave the dates the same.

Steve said that tryouts will be on July 15th for the play "Peter Pan" and needs to arrange a place with the city. Practices will start on July 27th in the morning in the amphitheater. The fees will be the same as last year. If parents volunteer they will get a discount.

Nola said she and Matt Jensen will talk and get that handled. Lori Seppi asked about the Police and she will contact Jon Rueckert who can help her with that. Lori said that the flags that usually line the streets have been sold and Camille will contact George Watanabe to see if he can help her with flags this year. Steve Aase mentioned that anytime there is an event at the parks, the parks department needs to be contacted so the sprinklers do not come on.*

***Lori Seppi said the NSL Book Club is going good and all that is remaining at this time is to hand out posters to the schools.*
