Domestic Farm Animal Regulations

NSL Code 10-10-6

Domestic farm animals:

1. Permitted Single Family Lots greater than 7,000 sq. ft. (P & R Zones)
2. Prohibited Multiple-Family or High Density Residential

Animal Point Value:

Type Of Animal	Number Of Animal Points
Chickens, rabbits, pheasants, ducks, pigeons	3 points each
Turkeys, geese	10 points each
Sheep, goats, llamas	50 points each
Roosters, donkeys, pigs, cows, horses	Not allowed
Nuisance animals (i.e., raccoons, skunks, etc.)	Not allowed
Any nondomesticated animal, including exotic pets	Not allowed

Animal Points Allocation:

Lot Size (Square Feet)	Number Of Animal Points Allowed
Up to 21,780 sq. ft.	45 points
Over 21,780 sq. ft.	45 points, plus 1 per 500 square feet above 21,780 sq. ft. (maximum of 90 points)

Requirements:

1. Annual Renewal
2. Site Inspection
3. Domestic Animal Enclosure (coop or cage for fowl and rabbits)
4. Enclosure Location:
 - a. Fifty (50) ft. from neighboring dwellings
 - b. Five (5) ft. from side and rear property lines
 - c. Located in rear yard only
 - d. May not be viewable from the street
 - e. Structures over 120 sq. ft. required building permit
5. Maintenance:
 - a. Sanitary conditions, regular cleaning
 - b. Feed stored in rodent/predator proof containers
