Be Water Smart

Turf studies have shown that most lawns only need to be watered once every 3 to 4 days to stay healthy and green. Watering everyday creates shallow roots. Watering infrequently develops deep roots and healthier turf. Grass roots grow deeper into the soil and become stronger with less watering.

Free Residential Water Check

Did you know Weber Basin Water Conservancy District will come to your home and check your water use? A water check is a series of tests on the irrigation system, performed to determine how much water the irrigation system is putting out (precipitation rate), the infiltration of water into the soil, and the distribution uniformity (evenness of the application of water). The Weber Basin Water employee also checks soil type, root depth and sprinkler pressure. The entire process takes about one hour and the homeowner is left with a customized irrigation schedule and recommendations to better the system.
