Vote-by-Mail in 2015

The North Salt Lake 2015 municipal election will be conducted by mail. **What do you need to do?** Make sure your voter registration is up to date. Verify this by visiting www.Vote.Utah.gov or by calling the Davis County Clerk/Auditor at 801-451-3217.

Ballots will be mailed to voters with an envelope to return your ballot by mail. Drop boxes will be available at the city offices during regular business hours until the Friday prior to Election Day. Feel free to visit www.DavisVotes.com or call the county office at 801-451-3217.

Vote By-Mail

- Ballots will be mailed 28 days before the Election.
- You will have time to study the candidates and issues.
- Vote at your convenience.
- Three easy ways to return your ballot:
 - In the mail
 - In a drop box at your city office
 - At a polling location on Election Day
- Verify online your ballot has been returned and counted.
