1. Events Update

Nola said the banners turned out really nice. The food turned out really good also and was not a lot of left overs which was good. Nola said there was only one case of water left. The city ordered the shirts but Linda would like to raise the price of the shirts for next year as the cost is only five dollars a shirt. The budget for this event was Fifteen Hundred Dollars. Nola said that so far it has cost Two Thousand Dollars plus the timing which was Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars. Alisa VanLangeveld said that it was good to know so they could budget better for next year. Alisa asked if everything for the race was documented so that it could be handed down to the next person when that time comes for change. Nola said that Lori Seppi who was previously over the race had written everything down and she has added to it since taking it over. Nola said everything is updated with every event and she will continue to be chair over the 5K race next*

year which will be June 29th.

b. Festival of Speed - July 2nd (Recap) – Bruce Oblad said the event was a big success and somewhat overwhelming as there were four hundred fifteen cars this year and a lot of people in attendance. 
