#### **1. STATUS OF HATCH PARK REDESIGN PROJECT**

David reviewed the status of the project and presented a draft design compilation based on the previous few meetings.

Also invited the representatives from G. Brown Design to say a few words. They reminded the committee that there are other things to consider – detention basin, etc.

Utilizing topography

196,000 people drive past Hatch Park every day.

Ken Leetham stated that the placement of landscaping is critical because over time – we need the shade.

He also mentioned that there is funding available from the most recent stimulus bill that could be put toward a community center that would provide services such as tax prep, career help, senior services, etc.

T. J. suggested a bit of a concept like Station Park – an open, year-round area; a comfortable place to hang out. Water fountain all summer long. Winter a skating rink, Santa, lights, etc.

Next steps – providing everything this committee has done to G. Brown. They would go through all information. They would dive in to developing further design options. They would get 2-3 concepts to present back to the City. Then you can get cost estimates and look at timing. You can look at phasing, etc

We'll look at challenges, such as grading – turn into opportunities.

Ryan added that letting everybody touch and interact with the park features is important. Community living space.

We just want it to be TIMELESS and EPIC!
