3. Public Works Update – David – Presentation

- a. City takes care of more properties since 2005 – From 19 properties in 2005 to 60 properties currently maintained by NSL
- b. Mowing turf 175% increase, added 31.07 acres since 2005
- c. String trimming 5.66 miles to 18.1 miles, 220 % increase, added 12.4 miles
- d. Current staffing: 3 Full Time, 2 seasonal. Struggling to hire
- e. Day of service Sept 11
- f. Dog park – Woods Cross is going to go in 50/50. Looking into outsourcing to property management. Working on a plan.
- g. Updated Replacement schedule: industry standards life span, tool for future funding, starting point and very flexible, 3.5% inflation
- h. Updated replacement cost charts . \$425k approved
- i. Next 3 years – utilize the parks and arts committee, use them to recommend priorities, look at different options *xeriscaping, etc, remodel/replace /repurpose
- j. Other ideas- Rock signs, cameras, epoxy for pavilion floors, themed pocket parks
