1. MINUTES APPROVAL

The Parks, Trails, Arts and Rec minutes of August 24, 2021 were reviewed and approved.

2. HATCH PARK REDESIGN UPDATE AND DISCUSSION

David Frandsen presented the 3 concepts for the new Hatch Park plans. The developer G. Brown Design Inc is looking for comments and feedback on the 3 concept designs. David Frandsen also shared that the South Davis Recreation District would like donated land at Hatch Park for a Recreation Center. Hatch Park would be a central location for the city. The designs also include a NSL Community Center.

Linda Horrocks mentioned that the South Davis Rec Center will be a paid facility whereas the NSL community center will be available for free programs. NSL resident tax dollars are already going into the South Davis Rec District.

The Board was in support of the proposed South Davis Rec Center being incorporated into Hatch Park. The proposed South Davis Rec Center in NSL would need to be put on the next ballot for a vote. Plans for Hatch Park could change depending on whether the South Davis Rec Center is approved for North Salt Lake.

The Board had the following recommendations for the concept designs:

- More Commercial space
- Living room concept (gathering space)
- Breezeway connection
- Business access from road
- No small amphitheater (event space or nothing)
- Better restroom locations
- No dog park/ No skate park / No batting cage
- Parking / exits
- Tree location,
- Plaza (tree, tower, commercial element)
- Fire pits and winter wonderland features

3. UPCOMING EVENT UPDATES

Tammy Clayton asked board members to promote all upcoming events on social media. She mentioned that she had seen many updates on social media, and everyone agreed that the events had good coverage this year.

4. PHOTO CONTEST UPDATES

Dallas Golden asked the Committee to vote on the photo submissions once they are submitted.

5. NSL READS

Ryan Mumford shared that the budget was \$500 for decorations, prizes, and refreshments for the Photo Contest and NSL Reads. Kristine Pepin shared the list of NSL businesses that we could get gift cards to for prizes. The Committee decided that cash prizes for the winners would be more desirable.

6. NSL SCAVENGER HUNT

Tammy Clayton asked about ideas for the NSL Scavenger Hunt. Rachel Shumway is working on putting the scavenger hunt clues together. Submissions will be due from October 8 through October 22. Details still need to be worked out on how to upload submissions. Details on the Scavenger Hunt will be shared at the NSL Reads on October 7.

7. 75TH ANNIVERSARY HOLIDAY EVENT

The NSL 75th Anniversary Event will be held on December 13, 2021, at the City Hall Amphitheater. Some of the plans include Santa, Tree lighting, Hot Cocoa, Time Capsule, Fireworks. This will be a fun family event.

8. HALLOWEEN FUN EVENT


