Tammy Clayton called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

1. PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE

David Frandsen mentioned that the Committee needs to start talking about the playground replacement plan. Ryan Mumford reminded the Committee that there would be no meeting held in November or December. It was agreed that the Committee would discuss the playground replacement plan at the January meeting. David Frandsen shared that he and others attended a Hatch Park meeting on October 25, 2021. They sent some additional notes and requests to the developer, G Brown. G Brown will be sending back a couple of new Hatch Park plans for review.

2. PHOTO CONTEST UPATE

Tammy Clayton said the photos look great hanging in City Hall. She shared that the winning photos will be printed and put in the 75-year time capsule. Dallas Golden suggested that we have a guest speaker for the photo contest next year and we award the same prizes as the Essay Contest.

3. NSL READS UPDATE

Tammy Clayton shared that the Committee got a shout-out for a great event. She thought the bookmarks were a hit and suggested they be included again next year.

4. NSL SCAVENGER HUNT

Tammy Clayton asked if anyone was participating in the NSL Scavenger Hunt. Submissions are due from October 8 through October 31.

5. HALLOWEEN FUN EVENT

Monster Mash Drive-Thru Event will be held on October 30 from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM at Hatch Park. Tammy Clayton asked for a camera for the event. Donuts are ordered and will be handed out on plates. Fidget toys will be given out. First 25 in costume will get monster bags. The DJ needs power from the pavilion. The balloon arch is scheduled for the photo op. The weather forecast is good for that day. Cars will come in the first entrance and create 2 lines so as not to block Center Street. Tammy shared that Serenity Dental wants to come and bring a treat. There will be 6 youth council members to help. Volunteers should be at Hatch Park by 8:45 AM.

6. 75TH ANNIVERSARY HOLIDAY EVENT

The NSL 75th Anniversary Event will be held on December 13, 2021, at the City Hall Amphitheater. Jon Rueckert is getting the metal garbage cans ready for the fires.

8. CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

Ryan Mumford reminded the Committee that the next meeting will be January 25 and shared that this will be his last meeting. The mayor will appoint a City Council member as a replacement for Ryan. Each member of the Committee is appointed by a council member. We have a vacancy, which Lisa Baskins is aware of. The by-laws state that a committee member will serve for 2 years, and some members may need to be re-appointed in January. A Chair and Vice-Chair will also need to be appointed in the January meeting.

Ryan Mumford said that the meeting in January would be a good time to go over the park replacement plan. City council needs the committee's recommendations before their budget retreat. As part of next year's budget recommendations, David Frandsen suggested that the NSL event signs placed throughout the city are too small. The signs are currently replaced quarterly. Permanent frames for the banners were discussed in the past, and he suggested that we relook at that option as well as placement at the January meeting.

MINUTES APPROVAL

The Parks, Trails, Arts and Rec minutes of September 28, 2021 were reviewed and approved.

Next meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 25 at 6:00 pm at the Public Works Building.
