1100 N. Construction Update

1100 North is now asphalted; however, the project is still a construction zone, so continue to drive with caution. The contractor will be installing

I-15 Reconstruction

Lane splits are coming in November. Two lanes will be shifted to the outside of the interstate creating a work

zone in the center. The first phase will split lanes between 400 N. and 1500 S. in early Nov. through Jan. Lanes near

Extra Garbage Pickup November 15

The city has arranged for one more extra garbage pickup in November. It will be the THIRD Saturday, November

15. Place cans at curb Friday night, as pickup times will vary Saturday morning. Beginning in 2015, our 2nd Saturday pickup will be extended to include May through November.



Winter Parking Goes Into Effect November 1

Beginning Nov. 1, there is no overnight on-street parking allowed between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Parking removal of snow and ice from is also restricted during any period that snowplows are actively operating. (This would be when snowfall is

accumulating on the roadway.) These regulations are in place to enable the efficient and safe public streets. Violation of this ordinance is a Class C misdemeanor and may result in a citation and the impoundment

of vehicles. The police and public works departments are requesting residents' voluntary compliance with this ordinance in order to avoid citations and towing incidents. These restrictions are in place until April 1.
